

How to make a complaint about a health service

You can make a complaint about health care you get from:

- hospitals or medical centres
- doctors, nurses or dentists
- counsellors or massage therapists
- other kinds of health workers.

The fact sheet says that you could:

- talk to the health service
- talk to the Health Care Complaints Commission.

In other parts of Australia, you could talk to a health ombudsman, the human rights commission or a complaints office.
